


2DAYS OF **ROCK ART** & RAFTING

Río Marañón flows through the heart of the Peruvian Andes carving one of the most spectacular canyons in Latin America. The district of Lonya Grande is surrounded by ancient rock art making it one of the most important zones in Peru for pictographs and petroglyphs. Add natural swimming holes, waterfalls and caves into the mix and it results in an incredible 2.5 day package exploring northern Peru.

TINERARY

Trip begins in the afternoon of Day 1.

We will depart from Jaen at 5pm or Bagua Grande at 6pm, and then begin the drive to Lonya Grande arriving in time for dinner at 8pm. We will stay the night at Hotel Renacer, where you will wake up to stunning views over the Marañon Valley.



DAY 1

At 8am we meet for breakfast and will provide a briefing for the day. After breakfast we pack our things and visit the Petroglyphs at Carachupa. From here it's a short, stunning drive down into the Marañón Valley. We arrive around midday for an early lunch, before hiking up to Cascada Libre and Las Cascadas. These are both stunning geological formations created as creeks carve their way through sandstone down into the Valley. The infinity pools overlooking the canyon are absolutely unforgettable.

In the afternoon we will complete our rafting safety briefing and then paddle down to Tingo Palaguas, where Roy and the Carrasco family will host us for the evening at their riverside beach camp.

DAY 3

Early risers are invited to explore the stunning Dry Forest which surrounds Tingo and venture into the steep walled canyon of Rio Palaguas. Early in the morning is the perfect time to spot highly endemic birdlife that inhabits these forests.

At 9am we will enjoy a hearty breakfast, and then launch onto the river taking on the exhilarating Palaguas Rapid. First up we will explore Amazonas Cave, then float down to the incredible Palaguas Rock Paintings the overlook the river. These were only discovered in 2019, and preliminary studies estimate they are at least 1000 years old and were painted by the Chachapoyan people. We make several more stops as we paddle through the stunning Red Canyon of the Marañón. In the afternoon we will enjoy lunch in Puerto Malleta, before arriving back to Jaen. Guests can arrange to fly out of Jaen after 5pm, or stay the night in a hotel.
